

REPORTING an Incident or Injury

Step 1 – If you are injured at your work site seek **<u>First Aid</u>** immediately.

Step 2 - Report the incident to the Administrator or Supervisor and CUPE OH&S Representative

Step 3 - Complete Employee Incident Report form on CLEVR <u>OR</u>ON PAPER (CLEVR user guides available on Teams). Make a copy for yourself and submit a copy to your school administrator or worksite supervisor.

Step 4 – Email **Employee Incident form** to Mike Messerschmidt at: <u>mmesserscmidt@deltaschools.ca</u>. Also send employee incident forms to Joanne Gill at: <u>ohs.officer@cupe1091.ca</u> or your union office at: <u>local1091@telus.net</u>

Step 5 – If the employee has been injured by a student at an intensity that would require the employee to also fill out an Employee Incident report, a <u>Student Incident Report</u> must be filled out. Email **Student Incident form** to Inclusive Learning at: <u>studentincidents@deltaschools.ca</u>

- All documents **MUST** be completed within 48 hours of workplace injury or illness on company time.
- You **MUST** be provided paid time to complete forms not on your break time. This is WorkSafeBC regulations.
- If you are not able to complete forms during your workday, you **MUST** first talk to your Administrator or Supervisor for permission to complete forms after hours.
- If the event was traumatic, ensure your supervisor is aware of how you are feeling and you take care of your mental health; take a break, seek help, reset. Your employer should ensure any unacceptable behaviours are stopped, and the work environment is safe and welcoming. Please see Mental Disorder claims sheet for further information.

Step 6 - Call WorkSafeBC Dial-A-Claim - 1-888-WORKERS (1-888-967-5377)

- File a WorkSafeBC claim even if you don't miss work. Every injury needs to be reported in case of future injury or loss of work.
- You can fill out WorkSafeBC form 6A but it is easier to call. They will complete forms for you and give you a claim number right away.

Step 7 – Go to your doctor immediately and let them know you have been injured or became ill at work. Your doctor is obligated to report to WorkSafeBC
